[Himmelfarb Library's web site](#) has a new look! At the beginning of the spring semester Himmelfarb launched its new website. The complete overhaul was based on the in-depth patron survey the Library conducted, enlisting feedback from both students and faculty in the School of Medicine & Health Sciences, Milken Institute School of Public Health, and School of Nursing. The task of redesigning the website was spearheaded by Michael Blake, Web Services Librarian, with the primary goal to improve users' experience locating and using resources.

We are pleased to report our website redesign produced an increase of over 80% in the usage of key resources and our mobile web traffic has sky-rocketed to over 115%.
