As we kick-off 2013 and begin the spring semester the Himmelfarb Library is proud to announce new improvements to our catalog, access to new journal titles, and fun initiatives to help us keep healthy and stress free.

One of the improvements you will experience in the next few months is a new look for our Library catalog. We are currently working on implementing changes that will deliver a more user-friendly interface, allowing you to quickly search for materials and access resources.

We are also continuously fine-tuning our journal collection to better meet the needs of our faculty and support your instruction and research. In response to the 2012 Faculty Journals Survey, a number of changes were made to the collection and access to over 90 online journals ranging from [Journal of Nursing Regulation](#), and [Anatomical Sciences Education](#) to [Advances in Nutrition](#) were added.

Last semester we launched a pilot program offering patrons a variety of **free** drop-in sessions devoted to healthy eating, exercise and de-stressing. Our programs ranged from Whole Foods Market cooking demonstrations to Zumba and Yoga sessions. The sessions were a huge success! In the spring we invite you and your students to attend our first event featuring Whole Foods Market cooking presentation on "Super Bowl Party Healthy Snacks" on Friday, February 1st at 3pm." Participants will learn how to create nutritious but tasty snacks for Super Bowl Sunday. The events are **free** and open to all!

Have you used our Health Information @ Himmelfarb search box under the Articles + Books tab? Himmelfarb is conducting a yearlong pilot project with EBSCO to help create a one-stop-shop federated search box that allows users to simultaneously search for books, journals, magazines, newspapers, trade publications and more. Some of the benefits of using the EBSCO interface are the helpful tools making it easy for you to print, email and create permanent links to the articles you wish to post to Blackboard.
