Trial access to [DynaMed](#) and [Epocrates Online Premium](#) will continue for another three months through March 31, 2010 as [Himmelfarb Library](#) invites GWUMC faculty, students, and staff to evaluate these two point-of-care information tools.

#### DynaMed

- › Disease information developed by DynaMed
- › Drug information developed by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists
- › Levels of evidence documented for individual studies and specific recommendations
- › References link to citations and PubMed with selected full-text links. In development: full-integration of Library's e-journals links
- › Mobile download included in subscription.
  - › Free download for all GWUMC users

#### Epocrates Online Premium

- › Disease information developed by the BMJ Group
- › Drug information developed by Epocrates
- › Levels of evidence documented for selected recommendations as selected links to to BMJ Clinical Evidence
- › References link to citation & PubMed with selected hyperlinks to full-text
- › Mobile download available through individual subscriptions.
  - › While individuals must subscribe to this component, a group discount may be available

Each of these information tools contains both drug and disease information. Please use these tools in clinical care and let us know how well they work for you. We are particularly interested in hearing your feedback on:

- › **Content.** Can you find the information that you need? Does the resource cover the topics that you need?
- › **Evidence.** Can you determine the strength or level of evidence? Can you locate citations/links to the original research or references?
- › **Interface.** Is the resource easy to navigate? Does the search work well for your topics? Can you navigate through the product easily?

Both resources are available from on-campus (including GW Hospital) and off-campus locations. From off-campus locations, you can login using either VPN/GWireless or ALADIN; for more information please consult Himmelfarb Library's [off-campus access instructions](#).

### Journal Collection 2010

Himmelfarb Health Sciences Library's journal collection has undergone a lot of change over the past few years, transitioning from titles primarily in print to an almost totally electronic collection. We currently subscribe to over 1,000 journals and provide access to an additional 1,150+ journals that are freely available electronically. Currently, only a few journals are published in print only, so nearly all of the journals can be accessed online through the [E-Journals webpage](#).

Last year's conversion of the Library's 2nd floor into study space has necessitated some additional restructuring of the journal collection. Due to space limitations on physical storage, beginning in January 2010, the print titles composing the first floor Browsing Collection will also be changed. Next year, the Browsing Collection will consist of 72 titles with high usage, including [JAMA](#), [BMJ](#), [NEJM](#), [Lancet](#), [Science](#), [Nature](#) and many others. Titles that were removed from the Browsing Collection will continue to be available electronically, so access be uninterrupted.

We also continue to analyze the feedback provided by faculty during the 2009 journals assessment project in an effort to provide more of the titles that are most important to research, teaching, and patient care at GWUMC. The Library's Collection Development Committee is reviewing titles that were suggested for possible addition to the collection. Also, titles identified as non-essential in the faculty survey are being further analyzed so we can ensure continued access to currently important titles and add new journals that were identified as important.

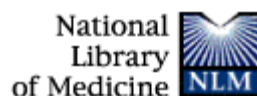

### PubMed Redesign

PubMed has a new look! The interface was recently updated, and while the functionality is unchanged the overall interface was simplified to make searching easier. A summary of the important changes is listed below.



### PubMed Homepage

The PubMed homepage has been streamlined to include an NCBI Header, Search Bar, and Footer that are now common to all PubMed pages. The NCBI Header includes an NCBI Resources pull-down menu categorized by topic, a How To menu, and the Sign In for My NCBI.

The Search Bar retains the database selection menu, and includes a link to Advanced search and Help. Additional Search bar selections, such as RSS and Save search, display after running a PubMed search.

Access to the popular tools and resources previously found on the PubMed homepage sidebar can be found under PubMed Tools (Single Citation Matcher and Clinical Queries) and More Resources (MeSH Database and Journals Database).

The Limits, Preview/Index, History and Details tabs' features have been consolidated in Advanced search.

### Summary Results

Changes to the Summary format include these modifications:

- Item checkboxes appear above the item number.
- Items in the Clipboard display the green note 'Item in clipboard' in lieu of displaying the citation number in green.
- Display Settings and Send to features (see below) appear only at the top of the search results.
- To move to another page, the options are now First, Last, Previous, and Next.

### Display Settings

The Display Settings menu replaces the Display, Show and Sort By menus. The consolidated Display Settings menu can be used to change results to a different display format, change the number of items per page, and the sort parameter.

### Send to (destination options)

The 'Send to' menu should be used to send citations to a File, Clipboard, Collections, E-mail, or to Order. The RSS feature was moved from the 'Send to' menu to the Search bar.

### Database Digest: Health Policy Reference Center

[Health Policy Reference Center](#) is a new information resource now available to faculty, staff, and students. The Health Policy Reference Center provides full-text coverage on health policy topics including documents from related areas such as health care access and delivery, administration, financing and economic, planning, quality, reform, insurance, law, research, long-term care, maternal and child-health, ethics, public health, and social medicine. The Health Policy Reference Center indexes and provides full text access to journal articles, books, magazines, and trade publications. International health policy issues are well represented with publications from North and South America, Western and Central Europe, Australia and New Zealand, East Africa, and Iran.



The Health Policy Reference Center provides a unique portal for identifying relevant health policy information and also adds considerable to Himmelfarb Library's full-text journal collection. More than half the 300+ full-text titles are new to the Library including the following peer reviewed journals: RAND Forum for Health Economics & Policy, New England Journal of Public Policy, Journal of Health Services Research & Policy, and Demographic Research from the Max Planck Institute.

The Health Policy Reference Center is published by EBSCO and the search interface will be familiar to users of some of our existing research databases including [CINAHL](#), [PsycINFO](#) and [SportDISCUS](#). To access full-text documents from your search results, you will see PDF and/or HTML full-text links, or you can click "Find it/Check for Availability" to search for a full-text article in the Library's collection.

### MDConsult Mobile

MDConsult has created a version of its website which is customized for the smaller screen used by mobile devices including smartphones (e.g. Blackberry, iPhone, etc.). This new access point allows GWUMC faculty, residents, and students to access the high-quality MDConsult content directly from their mobile device for clinical reference, research, or review. MDConsult Mobile also includes 'Recommended Results' topic reviews which quickly connect you to high-quality content on the topics most frequently searched in MDConsult.

MDConsult Mobile provides access to the following MDConsult content areas:

- > E-Texts - full-text access to more than 50 textbooks including Cecil Medicine and specialty textbooks.
- > E-Journals - full-text access to more than 50 journals plus the complete MEDLINE.
- > Clinics - full-text access to 'Clinics' series which provide clinical topic reviews in more than 30 specialties.
- > Guidelines - full-text clinical practice guidelines plus links to additional guidelines available on association and government websites.
- > Images - full-size images.

To access [MDConsult Mobile](#), you will need a personal MDConsult login/password. You can obtain a personal MDConsult login/password by accessing MDConsult via your desktop computer then selecting Create Account in the upper right area of the screen.

After you have a personal MDConsult account, you can access MDConsult Mobile from your mobile device by going to [www.mdconsult.com](http://www.mdconsult.com) and using your personal MDConsult login/password.

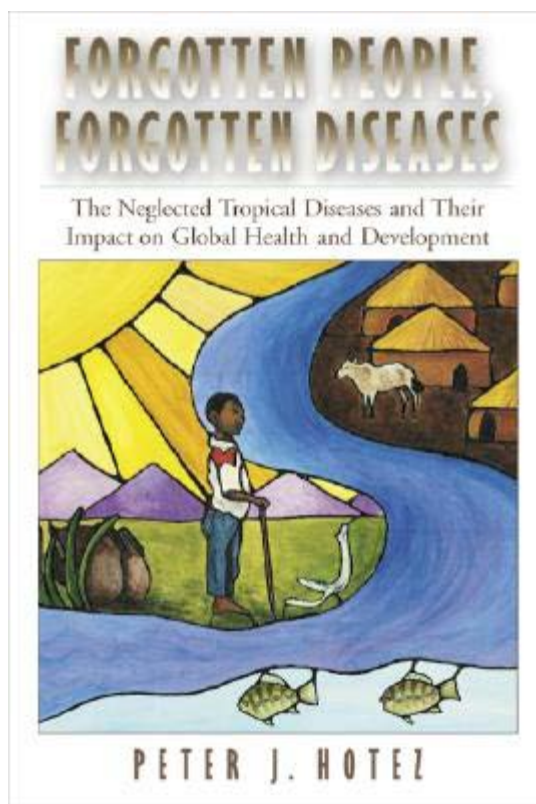
