

Documents2Go is our Interlibrary Loan Service (ILL), which offers faculty and students of the Schools of Medicine and Health Sciences (SMHS), Public Health and Health Services (SPHHS) and Nursing (SON) non-rush loans request of journal articles, and books chapters at NO charge. Please note there is a \$10.00 fee for rushed requests and a limit of 15 free requests per semester.


