Do you need to create a short video for a project? Are you conducting a focus group and need a recorder? Himmelfarb Library owns video and audio equipment you can checkout along with editing software to help you create a quality project. Our multimedia laptops contain specialty software like Camtasia that can help you create online materials. You can upload your PowerPoint slides, embed videos and images, and create quizzes to assess students' knowledge base. The laptops also come equipped with NVivo, a qualitative data analysis software ideal for qualitative research. NVivo allows you to easily upload your document in whatever format (i.e. WORD, Excel, or PDF) and code the content into themes. #### Editing software Available in the media development station and two curricular laptops

- [Audacity](#): basic multi-track audio editor and recorder that works with a wide variety of formats (WAV, AIFF, FLAC, MP2, MP3, Ogg Vorbis sound files)
- [Adobe Audition](#): digital audio editor like Audacity but a bit more robust; it includes various plug-ins for adding sound effects to sound files
- [Adobe Captivate](#): e-learning authoring tool designed for creating/editing demos and Adobe Flash-based quizzes and simulations.
- [Adobe Creative Suite](#): software includes tools for desktop publishing/graphic design (Acrobat, Dreamweaver, Illustrator, InDesign, Photoshop) and video editing (Premiere Pro)
- [Camtasia](#): screen video capture tool designed for creating video tutorials
- [Handbrake](#): video transcoder designed to compress large video files to a smaller size while retaining quality.
- [Pinnacle Studio](#): video editing suite much like Adobe Premiere Pro, Camtasia and Final Cut
