	<p>ClinicalKey: Drugs</p> <p>Search by drug name or class, information on indications, contraindications, adverse reaction, and monitoring parameters.</p>
	<p>DynaMed</p> <p>General information, uses and efficacy, dosage and administration, drug interactions, mechanisms of actions/pharmacokinetics, stability, preparations and patient information. (Mobile)</p>
	<p>AccessMedicine: Drugs</p> <p>Full-text clinical and basic sciences textbook collection that includes generic and trade drug names, drug classes and handouts. (Mobile)</p>
