- **Goal:** Platform independent COUNTER-conformant usage statistics for institutional repositories
- **Benefits:**
  - Standards based usage statistics
  - Ability to benchmark against peers
  - OA platform for authors, institution, and funding agencies to see
- Integrates with Figshare, Exploro, Haplo Repository, Pure Portal, Samvera/Ruby Gem, DSpace, Eprints

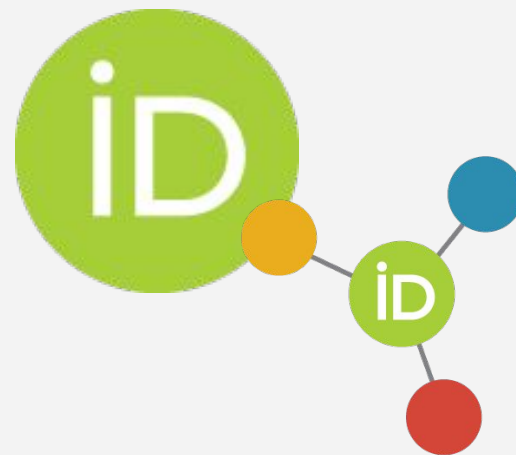

---

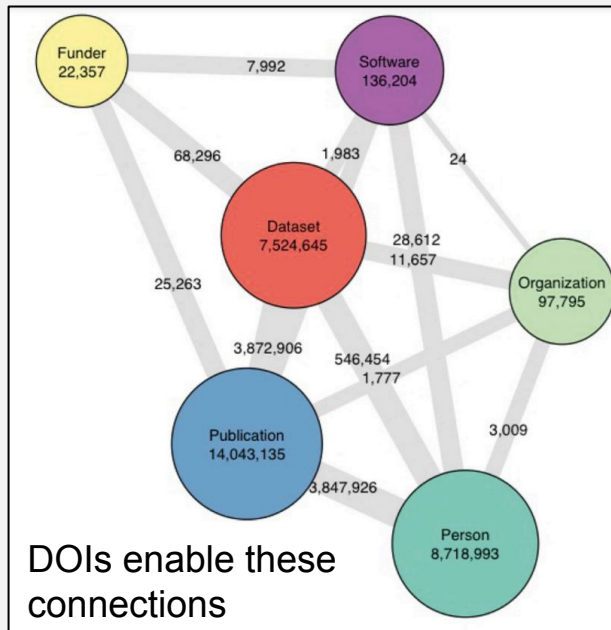
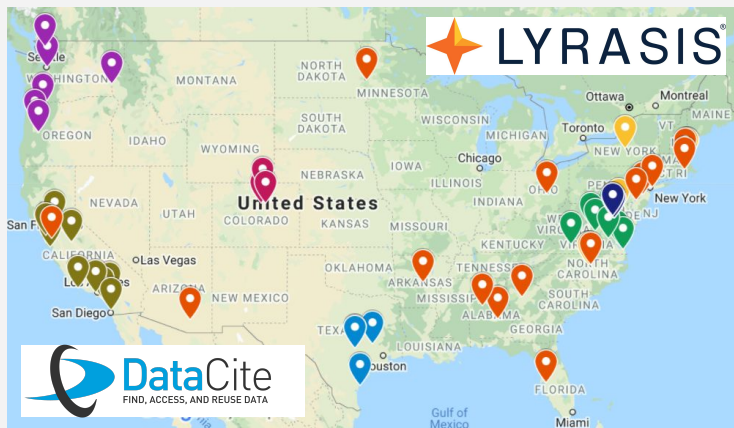
- **Goal:** Uniquely identifying researchers and linking them to their contributions across different systems.
- **Benefits:**
  - Disambiguate researchers using a unique persistent identifier
  - Connects researchers to their contributions via APIs
  - Dedicated Support Staff
  - Community Support
