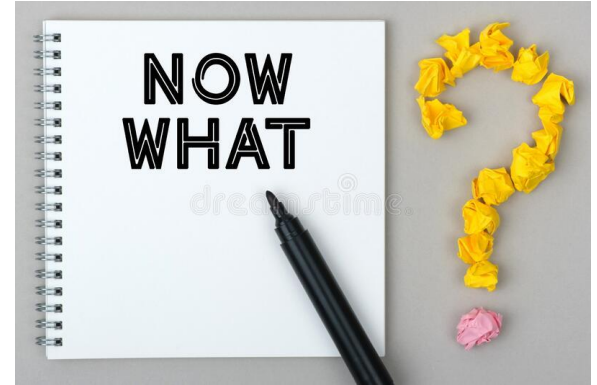
# Why start a journal?

- Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) requirements for scholarly activity.
  - In the 2021 requirements:
    - 48% of programs require written products of scholarly activity
    - 28% specify the need for peer-reviewed publication



# How exactly do we start a journal?

- Great idea...
- Had experience with Digital Commons but not aware of publishing platform.
- Currently Digital Commons publishes over 1800 journals!

  - What's working, what's not

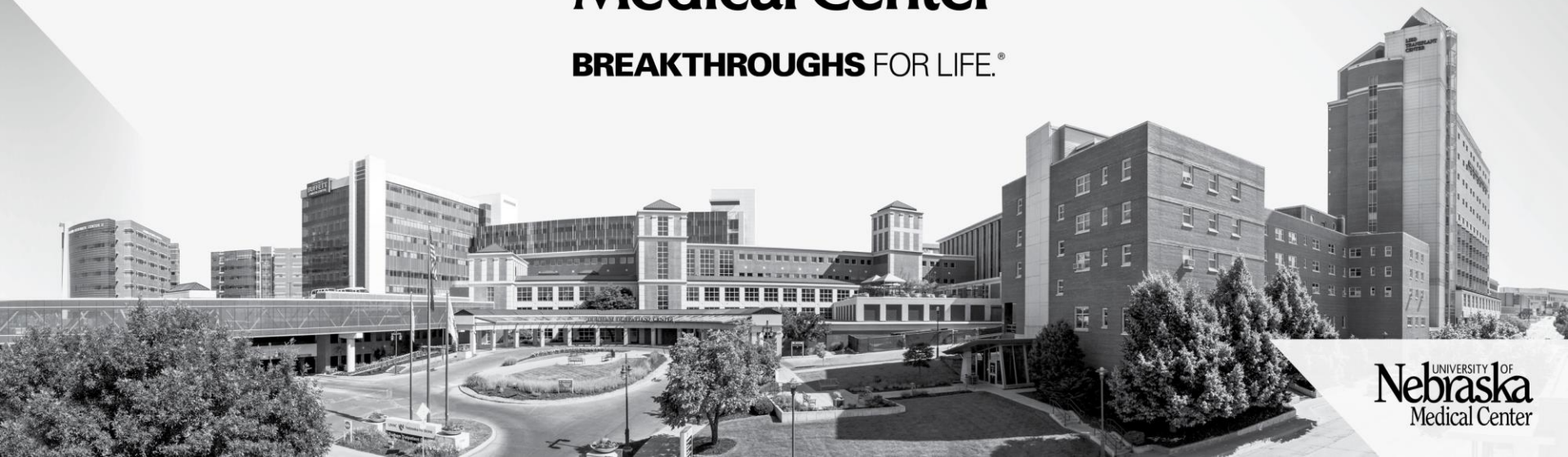
