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
Change in Uninsured Rate Among Adults 18 and Older 2008-2015

■ % Uninsured



Current Status of State Medicaid Expansion Decisions



NOTES: Current status for each state is based on KCMU tracking and analysis of state executive activity. **MT has passed legislation adopting the expansion; it requires federal waiver approval. *AR, IA, IN, MI, PA and NH have approved Section 1115 waivers. Coverage under the PA waiver went into effect 1/1/15, but it is transitioning coverage to a state plan amendment. WI covers adults up to 100% FPL in Medicaid, but did not adopt the ACA expansion.

Coverage for Medicaid Expansion Population

- **Ten essential health benefit categories:**
 - ambulatory patient services;
 - emergency services;
 - hospitalization;
 - maternity and newborn care;
 - mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral health treatment;
 - prescription drugs;
 - rehabilitative and habilitative services and devices; laboratory services;
 - preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management;
 - pediatric services, including oral and vision care.
- **EPSDT for adults under age 21**
- **FQHC/RHC services**
- **Non-emergency medical transportation**
- **Free choice of family planning providers**
- **Mental health parity applies**
- **State may supplement EHB package with “traditional” coverage**
- **Medically frail adults receive traditional Medicaid**
