When are you accepting artwork?	Dates: March 13th - March 31th (Monday-Thursday 8:30am-8pm, Friday 8:30am-5pm)
Who can submit artwork to the Himmelfarb Art Show?	Faculty, staff and students affiliated with the SMHS, SON, the GWSPH, as well as GW Hospital Residents & Staff can submit artwork.
Where do I go to submit my artwork?	Stop by Himmelfarb's Reference Desk to submit your artwork.

How can distance faculty and/or students submit their work?	Please email Synneva Elthon at synneva@gwu.edu for complete instructions.
What type of art do you accept?	Past submissions have included paintings (large and small), prints, photography, jewelry, pottery, craft work and more!
Is there a limit on how many I can submit?	We accept a maximum of 5 submissions from each artist.
When does the art show begin?	The 2017 Art Show will run from April 6th until May 5th .
Where will the art be displayed?	The entire 1st floor of Himmelfarb Library will be transformed into an art gallery displaying all of the submissions.
