SUMMER ACCESS POLICY

The Himmelfarb Library is freely accessible to the University community from now until after Labor Day. During the summer months, the library will be refining the parameters of the policy which limits evening and weekend access during school sessions to GWU Medical Center faculty, staff and students and others of the GWU community with demonstrated need for the library's resources. We are concerned with meeting legitimate information needs and would like to hear from users who have suggestions about refining the policy so that it will better meet their needs. MESH CONVERSION - UPDATE

Conversion of the subject catalog to MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) was completed in April. Since MeSH subject headings are used by the National Library of Medicine for Index Medicus, MEDLINE searches, and all data bases and publications of NLM, their use in the Himmelfarb Library card catalog means that users need only to be familiar with one set of subject headings whether seeking journal articles, books, or computer-produced bibliographies.

On the table near the card catalog is

a copy of MeSH in which all terms used in the catalog are highlighted in yellow. However, if the desired subject is not highlighted, the reference librarians will assist in selecting an alternative term. New terms are added weekly. Every term has a guide card at the left of the drawer with subheadings in the center and at the right. Subheadings are typed in lower case to differentiate them from main headings.

The Library is most appreciative of Gladys Mambert's assistance in this project. Miss Mambert, a professional librarian retired from federal library service, has volunteered many hours of conscientious and knowledgeable work on the MeSH conversion. We thank her.

VIDEOTAPE PROGRAM: REVITALIZING THE ELDERLY

Through the courtesy of the Gerontology Program at George Washington Medical Center, the AV Study Center has a copy of the videotape, A Coming of Age. The 33 minute program describes and demonstrates the work of SAGE (Senior Actualization and Growth Explorations), a project initiated in 1974 by psychologist Gay Luce. The SAGE project attempts to revitalize the elderly using a wide variety of relaxation techniques including

yoga, meditation, breathing therapy and biofeedback. SAGE, headquartered in Berkeley, California, has extended its programs to older people living in institutional environments. Programs focus on the needs of the individual and on employing the various mentioned techniques to help the elderly overcome physical, emotional and mental handicaps. Videotaped interviews with SAGE participants show the positive changes this project has had on their lives. For more information about SAGE or the Gerontology Program contact Nona Boren, X3721. STAFF ACTIVITIES

Barbara Lipton, Hospital Specialist, and Janet Taylor, Interlibrary Loan Assistant, attended a MEDLINE update session at the National Library of Medicine on May 8th and 9th, respectively. Participants from medical libraries throughout the area received instruction on improving on-line searching techniques, particularly with respect to different user groups. Emphasis was placed on search formulations that will yield more pertinent references for the clinician as well as the biomedical researcher. Practice search exercises covered topics such as the adverse effects of breast cancer on lactation or pregnancy, the medical and psychological aspects of political terrorism, therapeutic use of prosthesis for urinary incontinence, and radiation - induced neoplasms. The National Library of Medicine plans to conduct similar sessions in future months.

John Patruno, Serials/Bindery Unit Head, attended a meeting of the PHILSOM Advisory Panel of Serials Librarians in New York City on April 28 representing the interests of Washington area users of the PHILSOM system. The meeting was devoted to revising the subject listing capabilities of the system so that useful subject listings of library periodicals collections can be produced in 1979.
