END-USER SEARCHING

As many GWUMC faculty and staff know, online literature searching is no longer solely in the hands of professional searchers. You, the user of medical information, can now do your own online searching in your home or office using such systems as BRS/Colleague and PaperChase. Most of the systems provide access to MEDLINE. All are billed as "user-friendly". Basically, user-friendly indicates a search system is easy to use. Searchers generally don't have to learn detailed series of commands to conduct online searches. Instead, these user-friendly systems guide searchers through the entire search process with online prompts, menus, and help screens. A brief summary of user-friendly search systems for health professionals follows. BRS/Colleague, the product of a joint venture between a database vendor, BRS Information Technologies, and a medical publisher, W.B. Saunders, offers both bibliographic databases and the full text of over 8 major journals and over 20 critical care textbooks. One of 9 primarily medical databases, the MEDLINE file is available back to 1966. Full-text journal files include the New England Journal of Medicine, Annals of Internal Medicine, and Lancet. Access is also provided to the National Cancer Institute's PDQ/Physician Data Query file and to over 70 general databases. BRS/Colleague is menu-driven with options for bypassing menus once a user learns the system. Extensive documentation is provided. Individuals are charged an initial \$50 fee and a \$15 monthly minimum. System connect charges range from \$20-\$50 an hour.

LIBRARY MAKES BRS/COLLEAGUE AVAILABLE

If you and other members of your department are interested in searching a user-friendly system, you may find it advantageous to join the Library's group subscription to BRS/Colleague. Subscribers receive a password which can be used to search at home or in the office. Everyone will benefit from the volume discounts available.

Searching even a "friendly" system requires time and understanding of search techniques not covered in the system manuals. Free training and individual assistance from Readers Services staff will have you searching more effectively (and economically) the first time you log on.

The features offered by BRS/Colleague were the most desirable according to Medical Center faculty and staff attending Library workshops and demonstrations. Billing options make it possible to offer BRS/Colleague to the widest group of users. For those without equipment, BRS/Colleague Prompt Search software allows us to create local accounts for users who wish to search Colleague on a PC in the Library.

Like Lexis, its legal counterpart, MEDIS began primarily as a full-text database service. To date, over 60 journals and newsletters, including all the American Medical Association's specialty journals and JAMA, are available. System commands are relatively easy, but subscribers to MEDIS must use either a personal computer with special software or a terminal leased from Mead Data Central. Both MEDLINE and the NCI's PDQ/Physician Data Query databases were recently added to the MEDIS system. A monthly update service, ECLIPSE, is also available. The pricing structure for MEDIS necessitates group accounts. Minimum monthly charge is \$500. Online connect charges are from \$21.50 to \$32 an hour. Searchers are also charged for telecommunications and modification of search strategies. Onsite training is offered.

MINET provides both database and electronic mail services. The entire system is accessed through a series of menus and simple commands. A thorough user's manual is provided. The bibliographic component of MINET is primarily a clinical subset of the Excerpta Medical database back to 1982. A file of citations to socio-economic literature on health care is also available. Full-text files include such AMA publications as Drug Evaluations and Current Procedural Terminology. The electronic mail component of MINET, MED/MAIL, gives physicians access to electronic bulletin boards, PHYCOM/Physicians Communication Service, and CME programs of Massachusetts General Hospital. Individual subscribers to MINET pay an initial fee of \$100. Online connect charges range from \$20-\$39 an hour.

PaperChase, a menu-driven system, searches MEDLINE back to 1975. The system is programmed to direct users from keywords to Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) used by indexers at NLM. The emphasis on MeSH is designed to increase online retrieval and is unique to PaperChase. No user's manual is provided. PaperChase is very easy to use, but menus generally cannot be bypassed once a user has learned the system. There is no initial subscription fee or monthly minimum. Online connect charges are about \$23 an hour.
