SCIENCE INDEX ON COMPACT DISK

The Himmelfarb is currently serving as a test site for the Institute for Scientific Information's compact disk version of the Science Citation Index. The Permuted Subject Index has already been installed and is available for searching on the first floor of the library from 8:30 AM until 10:00 PM weekdays. Programs containing the Source Index and Citation Index will be added in the near future. Searches are done with this version of the Science Citation Index by following a series of prompts presented on menus. Please stop by and try this new way of accessing Science Citation Index. Your input is very important to the Library's evaluation of this product.

JOURNAL TITLE CHANGES

The Journal of Embryology and Experimental Morphology will be continued as Development with volume 99, no. 1, January 1987. The Canadian Anaesthetists Society Journal will be called Canadian Journal of Anaesthesia starting with volume 34, 1987. The Current Contents: Clinical Practice has changed to Current Contents: Clinical Medicine. The Journal of Ultrastructure Research will be changed to Journal of Ultrastructure and Molecular Structure Research. ACTA Pharmacologica et Toxicologica has changed to Pharmacology and Toxicology. The Journal of the American Academy of Child Psychiatry has changed to Journal of the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.
