Need images for class lectures or presentations? Himmelfarb Library has a variety of online resources available. These databases make it easy to download the image directly to a PowerPoint slide with the click of a button!

- **AccessMedicine, AccessAnesthesiology, and AccessSurgery:**
Use the search box and then limit search results to "images". When you download the image to a PowerPoint slide, the database will automatically insert a citation at the bottom of the slide.
- **ClinicalKey and ClinicalKey for Nursing:**
Use the dropdown box to select "multimedia" for your search. Create a database account in order to download the images directly to a PowerPoint slide.
- **Amirsys Imaging Reference Center:**
This image library includes x-ray, CT, MRI, and ultrasound illustrations and images.
- **JMAEvidence:**
Conduct the search and limit the search results to "images".
- **LWW Health Library: Medical Education:**
Conduct the search and narrow to Media, Images.
- **MedOne Neurosurgery:**
Use the Images/Video/Audio filter

Visualize Data With PolicyMap

Have you ever wanted to include demographic, income, housing, or educational level data as part of your research? Himmelfarb Library has a resource that can help! [PolicyMap](#) is an easy-to-use data and mapping tool that allows you to access data about communities across the United States.

[PolicyMap](#) provides data on demographics, real-estate, health, jobs, broadband infrastructure, and more that you can use to create maps of specific regions, states, cities and communities. Health data (including obesity rates, infectious diseases, uninsured populations, and births), as well as quality of life information (such as crime, transit access, length of commute to work and access to libraries) can also be mapped. By combining comprehensive data with mapping and analytics tools, you can visualize data and create a deeper understanding specific profiles for the community of your choosing.
