Himmelfarb Library is adjusting our services to meet your needs during the pandemic.

The Washington Research Libraries Consortium Loan Service (CLS) is back up and running! GW is one of nine local academic libraries that operate in partnership to allow expanded access to the collections at these institutions. Himmelfarb users can use CLS to borrow books and other physical materials at no cost; items can be requested online and will be delivered to Himmelfarb Library or the Virginia Science and Technology Campus Library. Himmelfarb Library is pleased to offer [shipping service](#) to students who are enrolled in online classes in SMHS, GWSPH, or SON; books from our circulating collection that are located in Himmelfarb Library can be shipped. We'll also ship books ordered through Documents2Go Interlibrary Loan service; if we do not have a book that a student needs, we'll borrow it from another university. Once we receive the book, we will ship it to the student at any location in the United States. Students should fill out the [delivery request form](#) to use this service.

Ross Hall Courtyard Service is now available to pick up and return library materials. Patrons who have borrowing and/or interlibrary loan privileges, but do not currently have on-site access are eligible to use this service. For details, see our [Request Courtyard Service](#) guide.
