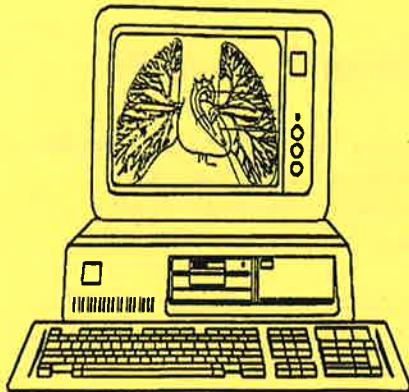

WordPerfect 5.1 arrives!

WordPerfect 5.1 is now available in the Microcomputer Lab on several of the Lab's computers. This version features pull-down menus and mouse support, but still recognizes the familiar function key commands.

Additional features of the 5.1 level include: Tables, which resembles a spreadsheet program; an equation editor, offering more than 60 functions/commands and 300 symbols; spreadsheet links, with the ability to import information from popular spreadsheet programs; a simplified mailing label feature; a new merge command language which allows for naming of fields in merge files; and the ability to preview and print the more than 1500 characters in 5 Level's twelve character sets.
