New CAI Programs

New CAI (computer assisted instruction) programs are receiving considerable attention in medical and health science library collections, and the Himmelfarb Library has added two new programs to its software collection.

Diagnostic Ordering in Clinical Medicine, by Alan H. Wu, University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, is a series of exercises in test ordering and diagnostic strategy. In various patient simulations, students are presented with case histories, followed by a suggested list of differential diagnoses and an on-line listing of available laboratory tests. Students review each case history, select an initial diagnosis, order lab tests and interpret results. Follow-up consists of interpretation of lab results and other diagnostic procedures, further interpretation, and selection of a final diagnosis. An optional multiple choice quiz on each case is available. Following each exercise, the student receives a performance score, and each exercise concludes with a detailed review of the subject material. The Himmelfarb Library has added the following programs in this series: Hematology, Chemistry, Microbiology, Microbiology II, Immunology, Endocrinology, and Cardiology.

Managing The Experiences of Labor and Delivery

Imagine this scenario: You are a student, alone with a patient in labor. It is clear that the birth is imminent, but doctors and nurses are tied up with an emergency C-Section. You call for help and are told "you'll have to do the best you can."

This is the opening sequence of a new interactive videodisc module called "Managing the Experience of Labor and Delivery," now available in the Library's Bloedorn Audiovisual Study Center. In this module, the student must care for a woman throughout the entire process of labor and delivery. The student is prompted to use judgment and problem-solving skills to perform interventions when necessary.

"Managing the Experiences of Labor and Delivery" was developed at the College of Nursing and Health at the University of Cincinnati. Educators at UC found it to be an "effective bridge between classroom and clinical experiences."
