## *Himmelfarb Health Sciences Library ...*

### **New CAI Programs in the Microcomputer Lab**

Two new computer-assisted-instruction programs, developed at the George Washington University Medical Center, are now available in the Library's Microcomputer Lab.

*Cardiac Cycle Physiology* was developed by Dr. Don Watkins of the Department of Physiology, Dr. Pierre S. Pincetl and Ren-lan Liao of the Department of Computer Medicine. This tutorial was designed to allow students to receive computer instruction in cardiac cycle physiology, and to test their skills after completing the tutorial.

*PathLab* was developed by Dr. Stephen G. Kent of the Department of Pathology, Dr. Pincetl and Ren-lan Liao, with assistance in the program design and interface by Dr. Shelley Heller of the Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Sciences. This program, designed for Pathology 201, presents four clinical case studies pertaining to endocrine diseases. The student makes decisions about laboratory and pictorial profiles (gross and microscopic features) that match the case, and decides upon a diagnosis. Correct answers can be viewed after completion of the four cases.

The creators of these programs describe them as a "first pass". They are planning for future enhancements that will include animation and the ability to interact with the graphic images.

They welcome comments and recommendations regarding the programs' content or format. Fill out an evaluation form available at the computer stations in the Library, or call Ren-lan at ext. 42473 with comments or questions about the programs.

*Cardiac Cycle Physiology* and *PathLab* may be used at any time the Audiovisual Study Center is open. They are available on six computers located in study carrels in the Study Center. Talk to AV staff or Barbara Collins, Microcomputer Lab Librarian, if you need help in accessing the program.

## BITNET Available

Medical Center faculty and staff can access the BITNET network through the University mainframe computer. BITNET was established to provide a communications network among universities over leased lines supporting 9600 baud data transmission. The network allows researchers to communicate electronically with colleagues at other institutions and research centers worldwide. A BITNET gateway also provides access to Internet and other similar communications networks. Users may access BITNET either through the University's local area network, ISN, or by dialing the mainframe computer. To obtain passwords for accessing BITNET, contact Kay Beach, User Services Coordinator, CIRC/US, ext. 40107. The Himmelfarb Library provides basic training to BITNET users throughout the year. ## GWCOMM Available

GWCOMM, produced by CIRC/US, may now be obtained in the Himmelfarb Library. GWCOMM is a customized telecommunications program for IBM and compatible personal computers which offers easy menu access to the various computers on the GW campus. Using GWCOMM, you can access all Himmelfarb Library functions, the academic mainframe on the main campus, and ALADIN, the Gelman Library catalog. You may also use GWCOMM at home. ## **New Computer Imaging Service Coming Soon**

In response to requests from our clients, Biomedical Communications, beginning March 11th, 1991 will begin offering a new computer graphics imaging service. This service is being made possible by the Dean for Research and the Dean for Academic Affairs who arranged for the purchase of the necessary imaging equipment. We will be able to turn computer graphics that you create on your own computer using *Harvard Graphics* into high-resolution, professional-quality 35mm slides. Initially, please allow a 48 hour turnaournd for the slides. Beginning June 1st, we will provide a 24 hour turnaround time. There will be a \$3 charge per slide. In the future, service will be expanded to include imaging files from a number of computer graphics programs. Of course, our customized computer graphics design service is still available for users who want their slides professionally designed.

Create your charts in *HG* preferably using the default color palette. Save your charts on a floppy disk (any kind). Group your charts to create a slide show. The first slide on the show should be a title slide with your name on it. If you have a printer, print the slide-show and, with a pencil, on a typical chart, indicate the expected colors. If you have used a custom color palette, include a copy on the floppy. Bring the printout and the floppy disc (with the slide-show and the corresponding charts on it) to Ross Hall Room 324. Don't forget to retain a backup copy of your charts just in case! Copies of the instructions on proper format of files for imaging will be made available in both the Department of Biomedical Communications and the Himmelfarb Library.
