

Keeping Up with the Literature: Highlighting BrowZine and Read by QxMD

Himmelfarb Library's BrowZine makes journal browsing and reading easy. Check out BrowZine's engaging display and create your own personal library with content available from Himmelfarb's journal collection including thousands of academic titles. BrowZine allows you to track your favorite journals through their "My Bookshelf" and "My Articles" features. Pick your favorite journals and add them to your library to access the latest table of contents and full-text articles. You can use Browzine as a website, or download the BrowZine app on your phone and/or tablet to automatically receive new content and alerts when new issues are published.




BrowZine's Key Features:

• Select, view and access contents from current and past journal issues.

- View new articles in-press. Get new article alerts.
- Mark journals or articles as read for better tracking.
- Edit labels and organize journals in "My Bookshelf".
- Save article lists in "My Articles".
- 1-click PDF download on web or any mobile device for later reading.
- Share or export citations to RefWorks, EndNote and other bibliographic services.
- Email or share articles on social media sites

With selected journals in your personal Bookshelf, you can create and organize article lists in "My Articles". Effectively manage your journal library by navigating between these sections.




To Sign-Up for BrowZine:

- 1. Go to BrowZine My Bookshelf and create a personal BrowZine account. You will receive a confirmation email to finalize your new account.
- 2. Search BrowZine by journal title, subject or ISSN.
- 3. To select a journal title, click on it then click the 'Add to My Bookshelf' button.
- 4. To use BrowZine on your smart phone or Tablet, download the BrowZine app from the App Store, Google Play or the Amazon appstore for Android


Read by QxMD

The Read by QxMD app and website provide a personal awareness service for health sciences professionals, making it easier to keep up with published research. The content source for QxMD is PubMed, and new materials become available as they are added to the PubMed service. To use

Read, create a free account login, enter your profession and specialty, and the service then uses an algorithm to deliver a feed of recommended articles.




Articles with high levels of interaction and views appear higher in the feed. Like a streaming music service, the more you read, like, and save on Read, the more tailored your feed becomes. You can also follow curated collections.



Other features of Read:

- Save articles to personalized collections that can be shared with colleagues or used for research projects, journal clubs, or other purposes.
- Use My Keywords to enter a set of keywords and be alerted when a new resource that's a match is added.
- GW users can indicate their affiliation and access full-text from Himmelfarb library's collection as well as open access articles. Downloaded PDFs are saved to the user's device.

The Read app is available for iPhone, iPad, Android tablets and smartphones. Read can also be accessed on your workstation via a browser. Read users with the mobile app can earn up to 20 CME credits for reading articles on the app.
