The much anticipated NIH DMSP policy is almost here! Effective January 25, 2023 all NIH grant applications or renewals that generate scientific data must include a detailed two page Data Management and Sharing Plan (DMSP). Upon award and approval of the DMSP, compliance with the plan is expected to ensure future funding.
