ATTENTION ALL USERS OF THE INTERNET! The UNIX1 and GWIS computers at CIRC are being replaced with a single computer called GWIS2. UNIX1 and GWIS passwords will not be automatically loaded into the new system so everyone who currently has an account on either of these computers MUST complete a new registration form. Forms are available at the Computer Information and Resource Center (CIRC) and at the Reference Desk of Himmelfarb Library. You MUST return them to CIRC, located in B106 in Rome Hall.

The Library will provide written instructions on how to move your address file to your GWIS2 account, how to permanently forward e-mail, and how to download e-mail. The UNIX1 and GWIS computers will be taken out of service some time this Fall so these procedures should be completed as soon as possible.
