ADDITIONAL ACCESS POINTS TO HAL

Four additional terminals have been installed on the first floor of the Himmelfarb Library for increased access to HAL (the Himmelfarb Automated Library). Library patrons may use these terminals to search the Library's online or reserves catalogs as well as the miniMEDLINE, PDQ (cancer information) and Micromedex (drug information) databases. Health sciences students will be able to use these terminals to schedule electives, complete course evaluations, and communicate with faculty and students via MailMan. A total of 17 terminals are now available in the Library. Patrons may continue to access HAL from their homes or offices via modem and other networks.
