The goal is to help preserve the professional activities of our faculty and promote the work that is being shared at professional conferences and during GW Research Day.

The process is easy! Fill out the online form and agreement, include information on each author, copy/paste your abstract, upload a PDF of your poster and complete all remaining fields.
